

ALC COVID-19 TASKFORCE (ACT) – DAILY UPDATE
20 March 2020

The members of ACT met this morning at 8am.

The continues to work with South32 and Airnorth to ensure all passengers to Groote Eylandt are subject to health screening.

The ALC language centre has completed videos and posters in language to update community on the status of COVID-19. This will be made available today.

The ALC yesterday circulated a request to all organisations on the Archipelago to limit contact between Alyangula and Communities as much as possible while maintaining service delivery. We request that ALC staff discourage community members from going into Alyangula.

ALC staff are asked to discourage anyone from going into Darwin at this time.

The funeral will be going ahead today. The last ferry to Numbulwar will go tomorrow, after which the ferry will not be doing trips to Numbulwar until further notice. The ferry will continue to operate between Groote Eylandt and Bickerton Island.

ACT will continue to provide daily updates to staff in response to COVID-19.
