Travellers need to keep up-to-date with where they can travel and which areas have been declared COVID-19 hotspots, as the COVID-19 situation in Australia is continually evolving.

If an area you have been in is declared a COVID-19 hotspot within 14 days of your arrival in the NT, you must:

- Contact the COVID-19 hotline 1800 008 002 and identify yourself as a person who has been in an area that has been declared a hotspot since you arrived in the NT
- If directed, you must submit to a test or assessment for COVID-19 infection
- Practice physical distancing (e.g. keep 1.5 metres away from others, stay home if unwell, sleep in a separate bedroom away from others, minimise contact with people) until 14 days has elapsed since your arrival in the NT.

Travellers must be aware of their responsibilities as per [NT Chief Health Officer COVID-19 Direction \(No. 47\)](#).

Don't put the community at risk.
