ALL travellers from interstate, including infants, toddlers and babies need to present a negative PCR test at check-in for your flight and on arrival into the NT.

Interstate travellers arriving on Groote will now be provided with 2 Rapid Antigen Tests (RAT) per traveller and will self-test on day 3 and day 6. There will no longer be any PCR testing required.

It is your responsibility to inform your local clinic if you return a positive test.
